New Zealand Alcohol and Gambling Law	Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act	Gambling Act
Object to licensing? e.g. On-license (new or renewal); Venue License, Operator License for Class 4 (EGM/Pokies), Venue Agreement	Yes <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Interest greater than the public generally;- If you live within 1-2km- Are a community organisation	No <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The only provisioning for community decision making presently is every three years local government reviews class 4 and board venue policies.

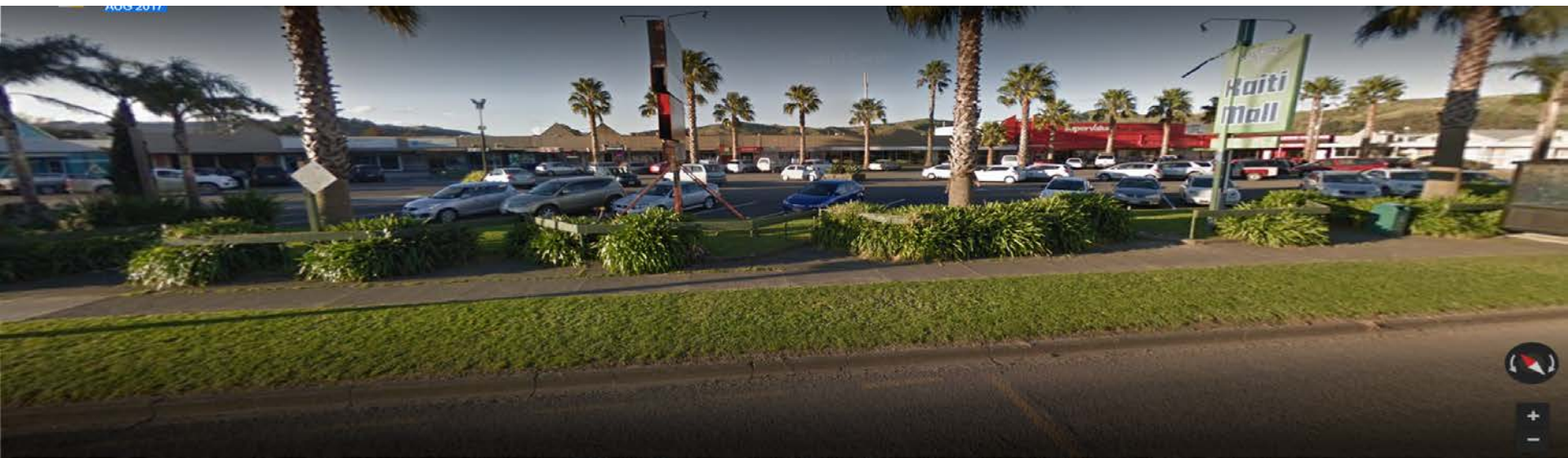

157 answers - 551 votes

I support the decision of the Gisborne DLC and urge the ARLA to quash the appeal 357607/2017 regarding Kaiti Club Hotel (t/a Kaiti Sportsbar) 122 votes **77.7%**

I support the removal of the TAB outlet at the Kaiti Mall and urge the NZRB to uphold it's function under section 9(2)(b) of the Racing Act 2003 134 votes **85.4%**

I support not granting alcohol licenses when the venue is being used mainly for gambling and urge the Gisborne District Council to enforce clause 7 of the Gambling Venue Policy 2015 when deciding all class 4 venue alcohol licenses 127 votes **80.9%**

I support the removal of the TAB, the class 4 gambling and the sale and supply of alcohol from the Kaiti Sportsbar, from the Kaiti Mall. 147 votes **93.6%**

- Appealed to the Alcohol Regulatory Licensing Authority ...



Hearing – District Licensing Committee

Ka Pai Kaiti

Objected – September 2017

- Sensitive sites – Churches, Multiple early childhood, schools
- Promoted School Friendly zone
- Cultural, Educational
- Mainly operating gaming machines and gambling, not a tavern
- no other suburb in Gisborne has the on-licenses, off-licenses and gambling that Kaiti does (amenity/good order of locality)

Kaiti Club Hotel

We are a TAB Tavern

Passed a Controlled Purchase Operation (CPO) recently;

Minor e.g. water, food

District Licensing Committee

Thorough inspection

- Food – range and choice
- Training – absent owner
- Finance

5 INSPECTIONS

- Not a tavern, mainly for operation of gaming machines and gambling
- KNOWINGLY operate illegally – in contravention of the Gambling Act – 67 (1)(k)
- Police queried non alcoholic drinks
- Medical Officer of Health – consider concerns raised by Ka Pai Kaiti

December 2017 - APPEAL TO ARLA

On-License declined

Appeal – Alcohol Regulatory Licensing Authority

6 July 2018

Kaiti Club Hotel

DLC wrong;

- needed stronger evidence
- failed to give due regard to matters
- not a tavern finding is wrong
- amenity and good order
- irrelevant considerations – systems and training
- irrelevant considerations – not suitable entity

Good order and amenity of locality – anecdotal

Ka Pai Kaiti

DLC correct

- Tavern principally for alcohol and entertainment

DLC Considered all matters

ARLA

- Agreed that anecdotal evidence was taken into regard however,

Overall, the DLC got it right,

ARLA confirmed the decision of the DLC

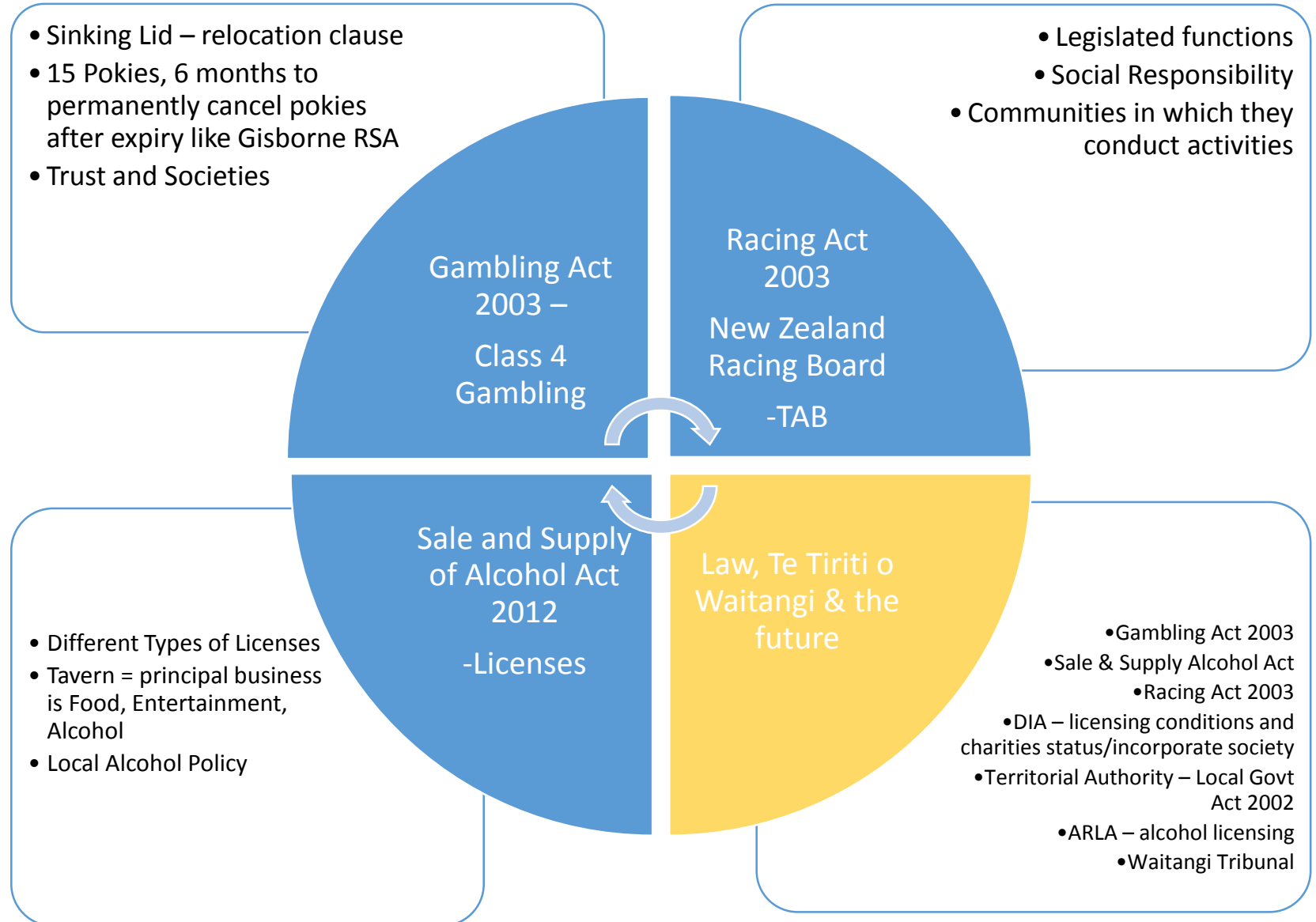
- Not operating as a tavern but for gaming.
